REMEMBER GUN SAFETY

DIRECTIONS: I-35 exit 33 (from Texas) or exit 40 (from Oklahoma City).

If you take Exit 33 east (Veterans Blvd) go 1.1 miles to Hwy 77/N (Commerce Street). Turn north toward Springer 2.1 miles. SEA Ranch is on the west side of the road, you will have to make u-turn back 0.2 miles to Ranch entrance.

If coming from Oklahoma City take Exit 40 and go east 1 mile to Hwy 77, then go south 4.9 miles to Ranch entrance on the west hand side.

MOTELS: On Exit 33 are the Guest Inn, LaQuinta Inn & Super 8 motels.

There are more hotels located south of Exit 33 off of I-35. Exit 33 is Veteran's Blvd or Hwy 142
